"A new town will be built near the Consolidated Fuel Company's mine which will be called Hiawatha. There will be a town of about 300 before the first of the year and this will likely be increased to 500 early in 1910. The company will have an output daily of between 2,000 and 3,000 tons. There are now fourteen men working in the mines besides scores on the railroad. Robert Howard is superintendent of the mine and expects to ship coal by the middle of November."
